### Position Summary

Under the direct supervision of the Employment Services Manager, the Job Coach provides on-the-job training and support for individuals with disabilities. The Job Coach is responsible for the following: task analysis for designated job sites; teaching consumers the necessary steps required to complete job tasks; working side-by-side the consumers to ensure all aspects of the job are done to the employer's satisfaction; and using appropriate learning strategies and identifying necessary accommodations.

### The Job Coach is responsible for the following:

- Facilitating task analysis for designated job sites;
- Teaching consumers the necessary steps required to complete job tasks;
- Using appropriate learning strategies and identifying necessary accommodations;
- Working side-by-side the consumers to ensure all aspects of the job are done to the employer's satisfaction, and safety precautions are observed at all times;
- Training consumers in all skills necessary to perform the job including (but not limited to) training in vocational, social/interpersonal, travel, safety, money management, etc.
- Maintaining professional relationships with all employers and consumers;
- Effective communication and teamwork with co-workers and consumers.

### Job Standards

Experience can be substituted for a minimum of one to two years of college education.
